

# Instructions for Authors

## Manuscript Submission

Submission of a manuscript implies: that the work described has not been published before; that it is not under consideration for publication anywhere else. Submission of manuscript should be submitted in word file or LaTeX file to [editor.jksa@gmail.com](mailto:editor.jksa@gmail.com)

**Guidelines for preparing your manuscript to this journal are given below.**

### Title Page

#### Title

The title page should include:

- The name(s) of the author(s)
- The affiliation(s) and address(es) of the author(s)
- The e-mail address, and telephone number(s) of the corresponding author

#### Abstract

Please provide an abstract of 150 to 250 words. The abstract should not contain any undefined abbreviations or unspecified references.

#### Keywords

Please provide 4 to 6 keywords.

### Text

#### Text Formatting

Manuscripts should be submitted in Word or LaTeX. A LaTeX template is available for this journal.

#### For Word

- Use a normal, plain font (e.g., 12-point Times Roman) for text.
- Use the automatic page numbering function to number the pages.
- Use tab stops or other commands for indents, not the space bar.
- Use the equation editor or MathType for equations.
- Save your file in docx format (Word 2007 or higher) or doc format (older Word versions).

#### Headings

Please use the decimal system of headings with no more than three levels.

#### Abbreviations

Abbreviations should be defined at first mention and used consistently thereafter.

### Footnotes

Footnotes to the title or the authors of the article are not given reference symbols.

### Acknowledgments

Acknowledgments of people, grants, funds, etc. should be placed before references. The names of funding organizations should be written in full.

## References

### Citation

Cite references in the text by name and year in parentheses.

### Reference list

The list of references should only include works that are cited in the text and that have been published or accepted for publication.

Reference list entries should be alphabetized by the last names of the first author of each work.

Journal names and book titles should be italicized.
